**2. Comment on the quality of the course design: Are the rationale of the programme (section 2) and the educational process (section 3) aligned? Are the resources (section 4) adequate to the educational process?**

Reviewer 1

The LO are based on Stakeholder discussions and are relevant for the beverage industry and the content is aligned to the LO. The knowledge is transferred by high qualified experts using interactive methods.

Reviewer 2

I found the course very informative and intellectually challenging. At the end of the course the student should have been able to apply what they learned. However, a food safety course management should not teach about the actual food preparation process but rather about management aspects.

**3. Comment on the relevance of the quality assurance system (section 5) and additional information provided (section 6).**

Reviewer 1

It should be written more in detail how the oral quiz, group discussion and a short presentation are evaluated: e.g. what is required for sufficient participation, or if there are grades/points assigned, what do the grades/points correspond to.

Reviewer 2

The material was developed very well and provided practical knowledge of the beverage industry. It covered many different topics and consequently did not provide enough details especially for what concern the management aspects.

**4. Recommendations (certify or not and suggestions of improvement).**

Reviewer 1

I would recommend to give the certificate, as the LO are based on Stakeholder discussions and are relevant for the beverage industry and the content is aligned with the LO. The assessment of the LO should be specified more in detail to be more transparent for the participants.

Reviewer 2

The course should be renamed in order to respect the content. I would suggest a two days course by inserting subject as process management, process data evaluation and so on.
